

Information for Grand Photos Members Regarding the Opening of the Photo Studio during the Covid-19 Pandemic

The Grand Photos Board of Directors, as required by the CAM Board, developed and submitted our plan for re-opening the studio during the Covid-19 Pandemic. The plan was in strict compliance with the Guidelines developed by the CAM Board for all chartered clubs and special interest groups. It was approved for implementation and can be accessed as a separate PDF document.

We recognize that the requirements may seem unduly strict, but the safety and welfare of the community, and our members in particular, are of primary importance. Grand Photos relies **on each of you** to be respectful of, and compliant with, these requirements. **We trust that you will be responsible for protecting the health of others and your own health, and will not come to the studio if you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19.**

We also realize that you may **choose** not to come back to the studio at this time, and we respect your decision. We hope that you will continue to stay active with your photography and engage with other club members in whatever way you feel comfortable.

If you do wish to utilize the studio, we ask that you **please support the monitor** in any way you can. CAM views member non-compliance as a serious matter. Monitors will be advised on actions to take regarding non-compliance and are authorized to call Security if necessary, and to report member name and CAM number to the club president. Your support of the monitor is greatly appreciated so that the experience for everyone is as positive as possible.

Finally, we cannot know at this time how long these measures must be in place. We ask for your understanding and support as we navigate through this very trying time.
